

Article 1

The casino mentioned on the front of this registration document after 'location', (the casino) under the name of Partouche Poker Tour, is organizing, under the name of 'Partouche Poker Tour', a first level single table Texas Hold'em tournament, subject to Articles 57-5 to 57-13 of the decree of 14 May 2007, concerning the regulation of casino games, policies, procedures and current rules.

Article 2

The tournament will take place on the date mentioned on the front of this document when the Casino's Poker room opens.

Article 3

Players that wish to participate in the first level of the tournament must obtain a buy-in of 2,000 for a fee of 125 € (110 € buy-in and 15 € registration fee).

Article 4

The winner of the first level tournament, that is the player that finishes with all the chips at the end of the tournament, wins a place in a Partouche Poker Tour second- level tournament, worth 1,075 € (850 € buy-in, 225 € registration). This prize is non-refundable and non-exchangeable.

Article 5

The first level winner will participate in a Partouche Poker Tour second level tournament, a tournament which is multi-table with no buy-in. The tournament date and location will be determined by the player's location and schedule.

Article 6

The structure of the second level of the tournament will allow at least 10% of the winners to each be awarded a prize of 8500€ (7,750 € buy-in and 750 € registration fee) for the tournament final know as the Partouche Poker Tour 'Main Event'. Prizes are non-refundable and non-exchangeable.

Article 7

The 'Main Event' tournament is scheduled to take place at Palm Beach Casino in Cannes, from 30th August to 5th September 2010, and will be a multi-table tournament with no buy-in repurchase.

Article 8

The 'Main Event' referred to in Article 7, will award a minimum jackpot of 500,000 € to one winner, once all the winner's chips have been returned.

Article 9

The dates, times and locations of tournaments are an indication only and will be confirmed by the organizing casino. Participants will be given a minimum of three days' notice of any possible changes, using all means possible, except in the case of unforeseen circumstances.

Only when a tournament is stopped or cancelled by the organizing casino, will participants be reimbursed the total value of their registration fee and buy-in. No other financial losses will be compensated.

Article 10

By participating in tournaments, the player agrees to photographs and audio recordings, to be used for montages which will be feature in DVD, television and other multimedia products.
