

<p>Article 1</p> <p>The casino, as mentioned after 'location' on the front of this registration bulletin, (the Casino) is organizing, under the title 'Partouche Poker Tour', a second level multitable Texas Hold'em tournament, subject to Articles 57-5 to 57-13 of the French decree of 14 May 2007, concerning the regulation of casino games, policies, procedures and current rules.</p> <p>Article 2</p> <p>The tournament will take place on the date mentioned on the front of this registration bulletin, when the Casino's Poker room opens.</p> <p>Article 3</p> <p>Players that wish to take part in the second level tournament must obtain a buy-in of 20,000 for a fee of 1,075 € (850 € buy-in and 225 € registration fee).</p> <p>Article 4</p> <p>The structure of the second level tournament will allow at least 10% of the winners to each be awarded a prize worth 8500€ (7,750 € buy-in and 750 € registration fee) for the tournament final known as the Partouche Poker Tour 'Main Event'. Prizes are non-refundable and non-exchangeable.</p>	<p>Article 5</p> <p>The 'Main Event' tournament is scheduled to take place at Palm Beach Casino in Cannes, from 30th August to 5th September 2010, and will be a multi-table tournament with no buy-in repurchase.</p> <p>Article 6</p> <p>The 'Main Event' referred to in Article 7, will award a minimum jackpot of 500,000 € to one winner, once all the winner's chips have been returned.</p> <p>Article 7</p> <p>The dates, times and locations of tournaments are an indication only and will be confirmed by the organizing casino. Participants will be given a minimum of three days' notice of any possible changes, using all means possible, except in the case of unforeseen circumstances.</p> <p>Only when a tournament is stopped or cancelled by the organizing casino, will participants be reimbursed the total value of their registration fee and buy-in. No other financial losses will be compensated.</p> <p>Article 8</p> <p>By taking part in tournaments, the player agrees to photographs and audio recordings in which they feature, to be used for montages which will feature in DVD, television and other multimedia products.</p>
